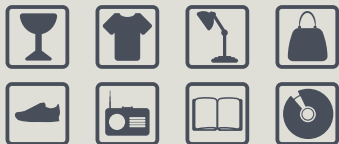
WHAT TO DONATE:

British Heart Foundation donation banks:

- Clean clothing and shoes
- Bric-a-brac
- Books
- Stationery
- CDs and DVDs
- Sheets and pillow cases

HOW:

Take your donation bag to a clothing bank, your nearest can be located on the map.



WHERE:

Place your clean items into a bag and take it to your nearest on street clothing bank:

- Brook Road, Twerton
- Victoria Road, Oldfield Park
- Moorland Road, Oldfield Park
- Oldfield Lane, Oldfield Park
- Canterbury Road next to the park
- Dartmouth Avenue
- Twerton High St, near to the railway bridge opp McDonalds

Banks are also located at both University campuses. Donations can also be made at your local charity shop.

WHEN:

The donation banks will be on site temporarily from April until 31st July.

MEET SHANNON

"Having a heart condition is always in the back of my mind but it doesn't frighten me like it used to. I'm in control of my condition now."

Shannon's studying a children's nursing degree at London's South Bank University.

She also has an abnormal heart rhythm that can lead to cardiac arrest. Like every other youngster, she never thought about having a heart condition and had no idea that, each year, more than 4500 under-16s have surgery for congenital heart disease.

RUBBISH AND RECYCLING

You must not leave rubbish and recycling out at the wrong time, even if your collection day is after you leave your property. Please plan ahead and put all your rubbish and recycling out the week before you leave – there is no limit to the amount you can put out.

EXTRA RUBBISH

If you plan ahead you can reduce the amount you need to throw away. Have a good sort out and donate as much as you can. You can use your weekly rubbish and recycling collections in the weeks leading up to you leaving, but larger items will need to be brought along to your nearest Recycling Centre at Midland Road, BA1 3AT (next to Argos on the Upper Bristol Road). Remember to take your student ID along.

The opening times are:

Monday - Friday 8am - 4:15pm

Saturday 9am - 3:45pm

Sunday 9am - 1pm

CLEAN BEFORE YOU LEAVE

Leave your property as you found it, including the garden. If you don't, you risk losing all or some of your deposit. For a one off garden clear up you can buy Council garden waste sacks. Put them out for collection on the same day as your rubbish and recycling (but this is a fortnightly collection so you need to check which week you are on with Council Connect or the Council website homepage). You can buy Council sacks at certain local shops - see list on website or contact Council Connect.

RESPECT YOUR NEIGHBOURS

If you are having leaving parties please warn your neighbours and keep the noise at a reasonable level. Don't forget other people may not have finished their exams yet, including GCSE and A Level students. You may be moving out, but more students will follow and have to live with the permanent neighbours.

QUICK TIPS

On top of the advice we have already given you, don't forget to:

- Refer to your inventory, is anything missing?
- Take your water, gas and electric meter readings before you leave
- Unplug, clean and leave your fridge and freezer doors open - this stops it smelling for the next students
- Ask your landlord if you can pass on any crockery or small furniture to the next students
- Exchange contact details with your housemates - there may be outstanding bills or information needed in the future (Council Tax, TV licence, Internet charges etc.)

- 6. Dartmouth Avenue**
BA2 1AS
- 7. Twerton High St**
BA2 1BY, near to the railway bridge opposite McDonalds
